- Adequate coverage of thematic priorities

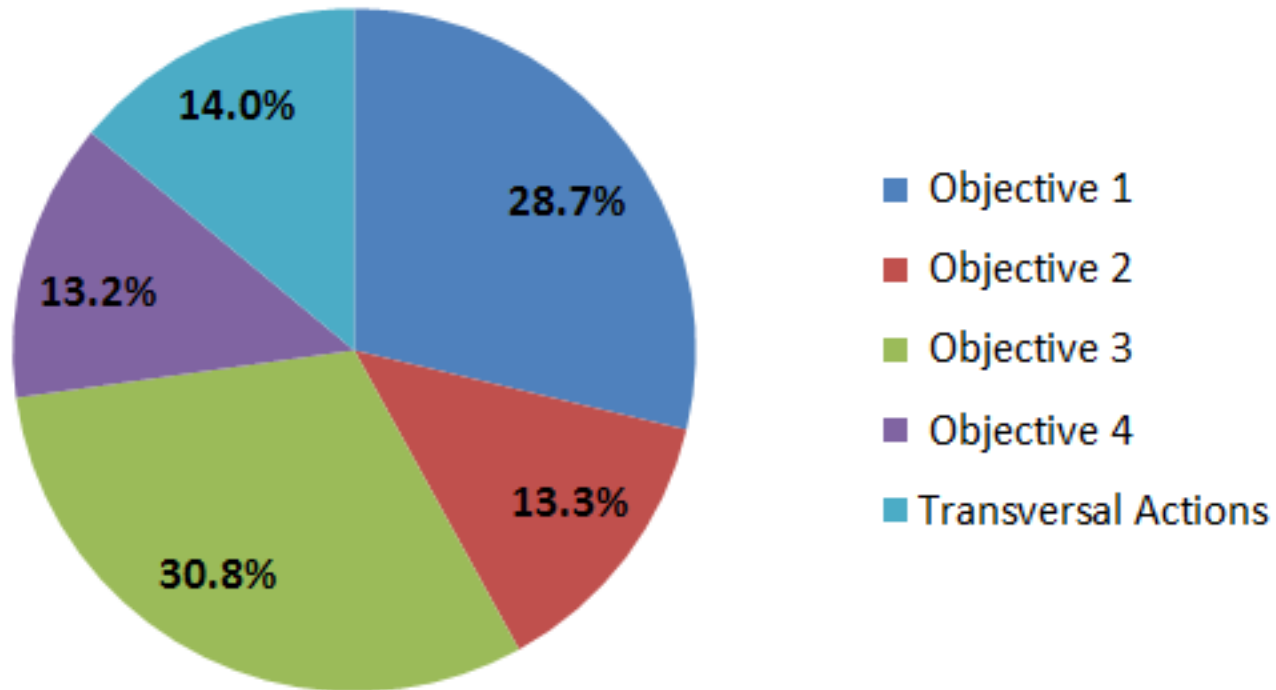


WP 2017 has been assessed against these criteria

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- EU Member States;
- Iceland and Norway;
- Serbia and Moldova

(countries which have a bilateral agreement with the European Union, in accordance with Article 6 of Regulation (EU) No 282/2014 on the establishment of a third Health Programme for the Union's action in the field of health (2014-2020))

European Commission co-funding

- *60% of the total eligible cost*
- *80% - if exceptional utility*

New: *There is the obligation for each applicant to contribute equally to the action' s budget*

Financial contribution to the functioning of non-governmental bodies (operating grants)

Call for proposals will be organised for the conclusion of four-year framework partnership agreements (FPA) covering years 2018 - 2021

In particular, but not limited to, the following priority areas:

- Prevention and health determinants,
- chronic diseases, cancer, dementia, rare diseases,
- HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis, Hepatitis,
- access to healthcare, and
- substances of human origin.

The programme has **4 overarching objectives**:

- Promote health, prevent diseases and foster supportive environments for **healthy lifestyles** taking into account the 'health in all policies' principle
- Protect Union citizens from serious **cross-border health threats**
- Contribute to innovative, efficient and sustainable **health systems**
- Facilitate access to **better and safer healthcare** for Union citizens

The Third EU Health Programme with a budget of **€ 449.4 million** is the main European Commission instrument to implement the [EU health strategy](#).

It is implemented by means of **annual work plans** which set out priority areas
